CARRICK CUP INTER-CLUB SCRATCH FOURSOMES 2010

RULES OF THE COMPETITION

This competition is governed by the NLCGA Rules and Regulations

1 ELIGIBILITY

- a) Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter. Every member must be a bona-fide member of the club for which she plays, and her club must have paid their County Subscriptions by 1st March.

Penalty – disqualification of offending player

- b) A player may only play for one club in any one season.

Penalty – disqualification of offending player.

- c) All players will play off scratch but **MUST** have Active Handicaps.

All clubs must confirm their entry or their wish to join the competition by completing the NLCGA Competition Entry form.

2 MATCH DETAILS

- a) A team shall consist of two players, the same players do **NOT** have to play every round.

- b) A match shall be one round of foursomes, which must be played to a finish.

- c) The Team Captains will decide by the toss of a coin which club takes the honour for the match.

All queries or disputes must be referred to the Organiser whose decision is final.

3 RESULTS

The team that wins shall send the result sheet IMMEDIATELY to the organiser, who will be responsible for the insertion in the Press.

4 GENERAL

The HOME team shall be responsible for arranging the match, by contacting the AWAY team and giving three dates spread over the time available, one of which MUST be a weekend.

Courtesy of courses for practice rounds must NOT be requested.

The final shall be played on a course which is NEUTRAL to both teams. Arrangements for the course to be used will be made by the Organiser.

On the day of the Final of this competition no practice round or any holes are to be played on the course where the Final is being held. Holes may be walked.

NB. Penalty – Disqualification of offending player.

Distance measuring devices are not permitted in regional and county competitions in accordance with Rule 14-3.

Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Regulations of NLCGA.

The NLCGA requests that caddies do not go onto greens.

5 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITION

- a) Suspension – Should a match be suspended (e.g. temporary stoppage – thunderstorm) mark the balls, shelter and continue as soon as possible.
- b) Abandonment – If the match is abandoned, the Team Captains must rearrange the match on a day suitable to both clubs.

Team Captains are asked to use their commonsense in situations not covered by the above.
