## NORFOLK COUNTY MEDAL 2010

### Entry Conditions

- Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter
- Individual handicap must not exceed 20. Handicaps MUST be active.
- Single entry.
- Players will be drawn in a split draw of handicaps PLUS TO 9 AND 10 TO 20
- Entries to the Competition will be accepted in the order of receipt on a strictly 'first come first served basis'. In the event of the competition being oversubscribed, unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waiting list in entry order.
- Entries will only be accepted before the closing date.
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within the fourteen days prior to the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- At registration each competitor must produce a current CONGU Handicap Certificate for that year. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap before commencement of play – disqualification.

### Conditions

- The County Medal shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Divisional Organiser.
- Distance measuring devices are not permitted in regional and county competitions in accordance with Rule 14-3.
- The County Medal shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round. Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in Stroke Play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay.
- County Medal Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions County Medal Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the decision of the County Medal Organisers is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Regulations of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go on greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
