GILLIESON CUP RULES 2010

This competition is governed by the NLCGA Rules and Regulations

1 ELIGIBILITY

- a) Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter. Every member must be a bona-fide member of the club for which she plays, and her club must have paid their County Subscriptions by 1st March.

Penalty – disqualification of offending player

- b) A player may only play for one club in any one season.
- c) All matches to be played on handicap – LIMIT 28. A player with a higher handicap may play off 28. Handicaps MUST be active.

Penalty – disqualification of offending player.

All clubs must confirm their entry or their wish to join the competition by completing the NLCGA Competition Entry form.

2 MATCH DETAILS

- a) A team shall comprise three pairs. The same players do NOT have to play every round.
- b) A match shall be one round which MUST BE PLAYED TO A FINISH. (All games must be played to a finish in case of later disqualification – e.g Playing off incorrect handicap.)

Penalty – disqualification of offending player(s).

- c) The handicap allowance shall be half the difference between the aggregate handicaps of each side.
- d) The winners of each match will score one point.
- e) The Match Captains must exchange team sheets up to 15 minutes before commencement of play
- f) Should any player fail to be on the tee within 15 minutes after the last game has started, her opponent on the list shall score a “walk over”.

The Captains of the two teams will decide by the toss of a coin which club takes the honour for the match.

All queries or disputes must be referred to the organiser whose decision is final.

3 RESULTS

The Home Team (H) shall be responsible for reporting the complete result of the match immediately on the forms supplied to the Organiser who will be responsible for insertion in the Press.

4 GENERAL

The Home Team shall be responsible for arranging the match by contacting the Away Team and giving three dates spread over the time available, one of which, must be a weekend.

Courtesy of courses for practice rounds must NOT be requested.

The final shall be played on a course which is NEUTRAL to both teams. Arrangements for the course to be used will be made by the Organiser.

On the day of the Final of this competition no practice round or any holes are to be played on the course where the Final is being held. Holes may be walked.

NB. Penalty – Disqualification of offending player.

Distance measuring devices are not permitted in regional and county competitions in accordance with Rule 14-3.

Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Regulations of NLCGA.

The NLCGA requests that caddies do not go onto greens..

5 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

- a) Suspension – Should a match have to be suspended (e.g. Temporary stoppage – thunderstorm) mark the balls, shelter and continue as soon as possible.
- b) Abandonment – If a match is abandoned, the Team Captains must rearrange the match on a day suitable to both clubs.

Team Captains are asked to use their commonsense in situations not covered by the above.
