NORFOLK COUNTY DIVISIONAL MEETINGS II, III, and IV – 2010

Entry Conditions

- Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter
- The handicap limit will be as decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee. Handicaps MUST be active.
- The Organiser should be informed immediately of any change of handicap that takes a player outside their division prior to the closing date
- Single entry or in pairs
- Entries to the Competition will be accepted in the order of receipt on a strictly 'first come first served basis'. In the event of the competition being oversubscribed, unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waiting list in entry order.
- Entries will only be accepted before the closing date.
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within the fourteen days prior to the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- At registration each competitor must produce a current CONGU Handicap Certificate for that year. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap before completion of round – disqualification.

Conditions

- The Divisional Meetings shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Divisional Organiser.
- Distance measuring devices are not permitted in regional and county competitions in accordance with Rule 14-3.
- The Divisional Meetings II and III shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying rounds. The Divisional Meeting IV shall consist of one 18-hole stableford qualifying round.
- Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in Stroke Play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay.
- Divisional Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions Divisional Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the decision of the Divisional Organiser is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Regulations of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go on greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
