### SENIOR LADIES' CHAMPIONSHIP– 2010

#### Competition Conditions

- Entrants must be full members of the NLCGA.
- Competitors must be 50 years and over on 1 January 2010
- If the competition is oversubscribed, higher handicaps will be balloted out.
- At registration each competitor must produce a current CONGU Handicap Certificate for that year. Handicaps MUST be active.
- Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap - disqualification.
- The Championship shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round.
- Single entry with a flighted draw.

#### General Conditions

- The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Organising Committee.
- Distance measuring devices are not permitted in regional and county competitions in accordance with Rule 14-3.
- The entry fee will be as decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- The handicap limit will be as decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- Entries will only be accepted before the closing date.
- No refund will be given for cancellation within the fourteen days of the event. Any cancellation should be advised to the organiser as soon as possible.
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in Stroke Play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay.
- The Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- Ties for prizes will be decided by card count back
- In all matters the decision of the Organiser is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Regulations of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go on greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
