NORFOLK SENIORS' CHAMPIONSHIP 2012 RULES OF THE COMPETITION

Entry Conditions

- Only FULL members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter.
- Competitors must be 50 years and over on 1 January of the year of the competition
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- The handicap limit will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- Single entry with a flighted draw.
- If the competition is oversubscribed, higher handicaps will be balloted out and placed on a waiting list in handicap order.
- Entries received after the closing date will be placed on a reserve list and will only be used after the waiting list above has been exhausted.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- A CONGU Handicap Certificate for the current year must be produced before the end of days play. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap – disqualification. Handicaps MUST be active.

General Conditions

- The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Organising Committee.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf 2012-2015, Appendix IV.5
- The Championship shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round.
- Ties for prizes will be decided by card count back.
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in Stroke Play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, is DISQUALIFICATION.
- The Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the decision of the Organiser is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
