TRANSPORTATION POLICY

CONDITION OF ENTRY FOR ALL COMPETITIONS

Players shall walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the Executive Committee.

RULES FOR THE USE OF MOTORISED CARTS/GOLF BUGGIES

1. The Player must abide by the rules laid down by the Executive Committee regarding the use of motorised carts. Breach of rules: disqualification.
2. Application for the use of a motorised cart should be made in writing to the County Secretary IN ADVANCE OF THE COMPETITION. Immediate authorisation for the use of a motorised cart may be given by the County Secretary. In her absence, application should be made to the Chairman of Competitions.
3. A player requesting the use of a motorised cart for County Competitions must be supported by a valid current Doctor's letter or confirmation of infirmity from the Secretary of their Golf Club.
4. Permission must also be obtained from the Secretary of the host club and the player must comply with any rules, regulations, and bylaws of the Club. A player who has been permitted the use of a motorised cart (and any other person who has been permitted to drive the motorised cart) must have adequate personal and third party insurance.
5. The user of the motorised cart shall indemnify the Norfolk Ladies' County Golf Association from any liability whatsoever arising out of the use of such vehicle.
6. The Player must ride at the walking pace of the opponent and the cart must be for the sole use of the player and her equipment unless the Executive Committee deems that for reasons of physical impairment a second person is required to drive the vehicle. No more equipment should be provided than can reasonably be carried by a caddy.
7. An able bodied person acting as a caddy would be able to walk along side the motorised card and fulfil her normal duties as caddy.
8. A disabled caddy, whether caddying for an able-bodied player or a disabled player would be allowed the use of a cart to fulfil her duties subject to 1–3 above.
