DIVISIONAL MEETINGS 2, 3 AND 4

RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. ENTRY CONDITIONS

- a) Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter.
- b) The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- c) The handicap limit will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- d) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. If the competition is oversubscribed the remainder of entries will be placed on a waiting list in entry order.
- e) Late entries received after the closing date will only be considered if maximum field has not been achieved.
- f) Cancellations should be advised to the Competition Organiser as soon as possible.
- g) No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the competition.
- h) Players must have a Competition Handicap.
- i) A current CONGU Handicap Certificate must be produced before the end of the day's play.
Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap is disqualification.

2. CONDITIONS

- a) The Divisional Meetings will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Competition Organiser.
- b) Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf Appendix IV.5.
- c) Divisional Meeting 2 will consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round.
- d) Divisional Meetings 3 and 4 will consist of one 18-hole stableford qualifying round.
- e) Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback.
- f) If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the Competition Organiser will add two strokes to the first hole in stroke play and deduct two points from the total points scored in stableford. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty under Rule 33-7, is disqualification.
- g) The Competition Organiser reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- h) In the event of adverse weather conditions the Competition Organiser reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- i) In all matters, the Competition Organiser's decision is final.
- j) Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of the NLCGA.
- k) Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- l) Players may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
