#### CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1.1 The competition is open to players who are members of an affiliated Golf Club within the Counties of Bedfordshire, Cambs & Hunts, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk and Suffolk, who have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A Rules Limited and who hold a Competition CONGU handicap at the date of entry.

#### Regulations

- 2.1 Entries shall be limited to 60 pairs
- 2.2 Entry forms and the appropriate fee must reach the organiser by the closing date of Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018
- 2.3 In the event of entries exceeding 60 pairs, the additional players will be kept on a reserve list
- 2.4 The competition draw will be made after the 23<sup>rd</sup> March and participants notified.
- 2.5 Competitors **MUST** register at the Registration Desk **no later than 30 minutes before their first tee time.**
- 2.6 A current Competition CONGU Handicap must be held by the player. Failure in this respect will lead to disqualification
- 2.7 Any competitor who is aged under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult
- 2.8 The organiser has the authority to arrange/alter tee times, with appropriate notification to those affected
- 2.9 In the event of adverse conditions, the organiser reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result
- 2.10 A player withdrawing after the closing date **MUST** inform the organiser:

Entry fees are not refundable after the closing date unless a substitute can be arranged
- 2.11 **In all matters, the decision of the organiser is final**

#### Conditions

- 3.1 The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and England Golf Hard Card
- 3.2 The competition shall consist of 36 holes stroke play in foursomes format
- 3.3 In the event of a tie after 36 holes the winners will be decided on a count back basis over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card. Players may only win one prize.
- 3.4 If a player arrives at their starting point ready to play within five minutes after their starting time and in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33.7, the penalty of loss of **TWO STROKES** will be applied. The penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is **DISQUALIFICATION.**
- 3.5 The ball used must be on the R&A Conforming Ball list. Non-compliance results in disqualification.
- 3.6 Distance measuring devices may be used
- 3.7 Competitors must walk at all times during the competition A golf buggy may be used by a player who can provide a valid current medical certificate of disability and has requested permission from the organiser 7 days prior to the competition.
- 3.8 Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.
- 3.9 The organiser and referees will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play
