

JUNIOR SPRING MEETING TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. ENTRY CONDITIONS: Spring Trophy

- a. Only JUNIOR members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter who are under 18 on 1st January in the year of the competition
- b. For Girls with a Handicap Index up to 40 issued from a 'Golf Club' (as defined in the Rules of Handicapping Book) that is authorised to use the Rules of Handicapping.
- c. The competition will consist of one 18-hole round of stableford.
- d. The stroke allowance is 95% of the course handicap on the course being played
- e. Any cancellations should be advised to the Competition Organiser as soon as possible.

2. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as approved by the Competition Organiser.
- b. Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf (Rule 4-3).
- c. Ties will be decided by card countback.
- d. The Competition Organiser reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- e. In all matters the decision of the Competition Organiser is final.
- f. Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of NLCGA.
- g. Caddies are not permitted. The NLCGA does NOT allow spectators to walk on the fairways or speak to s to players during the competition.
- h. Mobile phones MUST be switched OFF during play and can only be used in cases of an emergency.
- i. The Dress Code of the host Club must be adhered to.

9-HOLE STABLEFORD

9-hole Stableford

- a. For Girls with a Handicap Index of 41-54 issued from a 'Golf Club' (as defined in the Rules of Handicapping Book) that is authorised to use the Rules of Handicapping. And those without a Handicap.
- b. The competition will consist of 9-holes of stableford or as many holes as the Competition Organiser decides.
- c. The stroke allowance is 95% of the course handicap on the course being played.

9-HOLE GREENSOMES

- a. Two-person team consisting of a girl without a Handicap Index and an adult player.
- b. The competition will consist of 9-holes of Greensomes or as many holes many holes as the Competition Organiser decides.
