TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. ENTRY CONDITIONS

- a) Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter.
- b) Players must be 50 years and over on the day of the competition.
- c) The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- d) The Handicap Index limit will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- e) If the competition is oversubscribed ladies with higher Handicap Indices will be balloted out and placed on a waiting list in Handicap Index order.
- f) Entries received after the closing date will be placed on a reserve list and will only be used after the waiting list above has been exhausted.
- g) Cancellations should be advised to the Competition Organiser as soon as possible.
- h) No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the competition.
- i) Players must have a Handicap Index issued from a 'Golf Club' (as defined in the Rules of Handicapping Book) that is authorised to use the Rules of Handicapping.

2. CONDITIONS

- a) The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Competition Organiser.
- b) Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf (Rule 4-3).
- c) The Championship will consist of one 18 hole stroke play round.
- d) Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback.
- e) If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the Competition Organiser will add two strokes to the first hole in stroke play and deduct two points from the total points scored in stableford. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty under Rules of Golf (Rule 5-3) is disqualification.
- f) The Competition Organiser reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- g) In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Competition Organiser reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- h) In all matters, the Competition Organiser's decision is final.
- i) Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of the NLCGA.
- j) Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- k) Players may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
